Eligibility

- Open to artists who have been active members of MMFAS at least three months prior to this exhibit.
- Original works of fine art using accepted media listed in article one of the Constitution: Painting, Sculpture, Drawing, Ceramics, Photography, very fine Jewelry, Fiber Arts, and original artist Prints.
- Work must have been completed in 2023 or later.
- Works that have been awarded first, second, or third prizes in any previous MMFAS shows are ineligible.
- Image size must not exceed a 24" x 36" area.
- All artwork, including sold work, must remain in the gallery until Wednesday, December 9th. The college cannot store any works before the drop-off time or after the pickup time. If you are unable to deliver or pick up work on time, please make arrangements.
- No commission will be charged on sales of work. The East Central College art department will coordinate all sales.
- All two-dimensional works must be framed or gallery wrapped and wired. Saw-tooth hangers are unstable and not allowed. Artwork not in compliance will not be accepted.
- The show committee alone has the power to enforce rules of this exhibition.

Categories of work

The traditional media categories have been consolidated into five major groups, so please read the following descriptions carefully:

Painting- any painting medium including Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Gouache, Pastel, Tempera, Encaustic, Alcohol, Enamel, or any other wet media.

Drawing- any drawing medium including Graphite Pencil, Pen, Colored Pencil, Pastel, Charcoal, Ink, Pyrography, or any other drawing media.

Mixed Media- any work that uses a combination of separate media or Collage.

3-Dimensional- any Sculpture medium, Ceramics or Fiber Art.

Photography and Printmaking- any black & white or color digital or analog photographic medium, any original artist print medium such as Relief, Intaglio, Screen Print, Lithography, or Monotype.

Awards

The judge may award

- First, Second, Third, and Honorable Mention ribbons in each of the five major groups.
- The annual Father Bukauskas award. This year's theme is "Snow". Each member may submit only one work for this theme.
- A People's Choice award, a non-monetary ribbon shall be awarded at the club Christmas party.

The award monetary values will be based on the total fees collected from submissions.

Entry Fee- \$5.00 per item

There is no limit to the number of eligible works members may submit in any category or categories.
